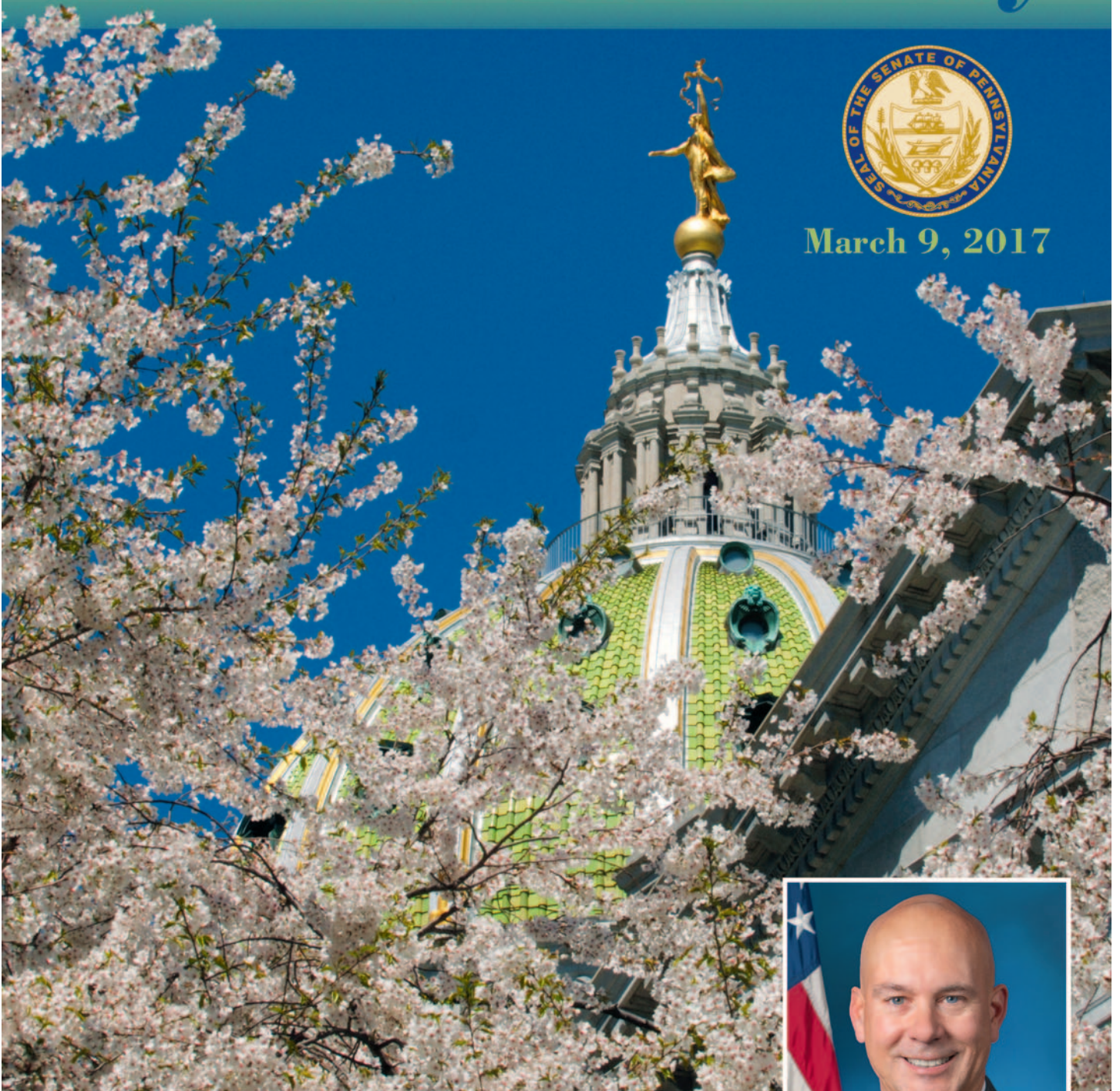

Senators will divide into Senate committees to discuss bills, take positions on legislation, and actually draft laws for the full Senate to consider in the afternoon General Session.

Education Committee

- Senate Bill 9 – Extracurricular Activities Assessment Fee
- Senate Bill 10 – Providing for Year-Round Schooling

Finance Committee

- Senate Bill 3 – Pension Reform
- Senate Bill 4 – Shale Tax

Game and Fisheries Committee

- Senate Bill 7 – Prohibition on Sunday Hunting
- Senate Bill 8 – Allowing Game Commission to Set Its Own License Fees

Law and Justice Committee

- Senate Bill 1 – Rights to Social Media Upon Death
- Senate Bill 2 – Liquor Store Modernization

Transportation Committee

- Senate Bill 5 – Voter Identification
- Senate Bill 6 – Seat Belts on School Buses and School Vehicles

The Senate will meet in full session to debate and vote on legislation drafted by the various committees. Each committee chairman will present the bills to the Senate for debate and a final vote.

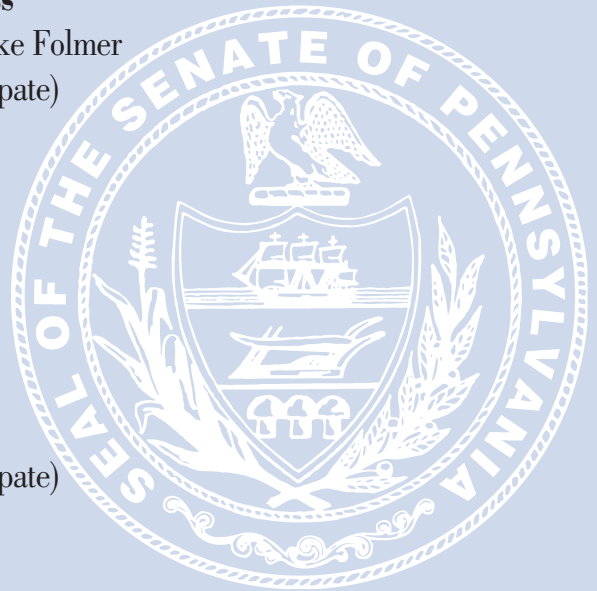
