Banning Gas Stoves

This legislation will phase out new gas stove manufacturing year by year and ban manufacturing of gas stoves by the year 2030.

- Pennsylvania manufacturers of gas stoves for commercial and industrial use are required to replace 10% of their new gas stove manufacturing output per year, with electric stoves until the year 2034;
- Gas stove manufacturers cannot produce new gas stoves from 2034 onward.
- Retail stores and vendors in Pennsylvania must pay an additional 5 percent tax on imported gas stoves meant for sale within Commonwealth borders; this tax is levied in addition to the standard “use tax” that applies to goods and services from out-of-state.

This act shall take effect beginning January 1, 2025.
