<b>BILL NO.</b>	<b>TITLE of BILL</b>	<b>ACTION</b>
<b>SENATE 1</b>	<b>K-12 School Day Start (Education)</b> This bill will provide that all of Pennsylvania’s elementary and secondary public schools may not begin class before 9:00 AM.	
<b>SENATE 2</b>	<b>Firearms in Schools (Education)</b> This bill would give schools the option to allow certain school personnel to have access to firearms in school buildings.	
<b>SENATE 3</b>	<b>Preservation of Historic Sites (State Government)</b> This bill states that a public monument may not be permanently removed, except as specifically approved by an act of the General Assembly.	
<b>SENATE 4</b>	<b>Drug Testing for Welfare Benefits (State Government)</b> The Department of Human Services shall develop and implement a drug test and drug retest program for applicants and recipients of public assistance benefits.	
<b>SENATE 5</b>	<b>Parental Consent to Join Online Social Networks (Law and Justice)</b> An Act stating a social media company may not approve the creation of an account for a minor without written consent of the minor’s parent or legal guardian.	
<b>SENATE 6</b>	<b>Abolishing the Death Penalty (Law and Justice)</b> An Act stating the death penalty will no longer be offered as a means of punishment for certain levels of murder and arson.	
<b>SENATE 7</b>	<b>Banning Gas Stoves (Environmental)</b> This bill would phase out gas stoves and ultimately ban manufacturing of all new gas stoves by the year 2030.	
<b>SENATE 8</b>	<b>Plastic Bag Tax Act (Environmental)</b> An act providing a 25-cent tax on all plastic grocery bags.	
<b>SENATE 9</b>	<b>Mileage-Based User Fee (Transportation)</b> This bill would require electric and hybrid plug-in vehicle drivers to pay for miles driven on Pennsylvania roads.	
<b>SENATE 10</b>	<b>Ban Cell Phones While Driving (Transportation)</b> The use of a hand-held cellular phone while operating a motor vehicle that is in motion upon a public roadway is prohibited.
